The OSPS Autumn Family Fete

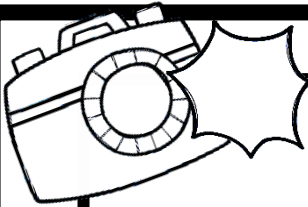

Reports

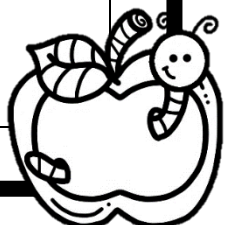
