WHAT TO BRING:

- **Parents: Please supervise your child packing and ensure all items are packed and that your child knows what is in their bag. Pack together, not for them.**
- **Children: Please tick off as you pack these items!**
- **All items MUST BE CLEARLY NAMED.**

1. Overnight bag with luggage label.
2. Backpack – to carry food, drink, coats etc at venues.
3. T-shirts or long sleeved shirts x 3 or 4.
4. Jumper x 2.
5. Casual pants (jeans or track pants – loose and comfortable) x 2.
6. **Warm**, rain proof coat.
7. Gloves and hat (optional).
8. Sleepwear.
9. Underwear x 4.
10. Plastic bag for dirty clothes.
11. Socks x 4.
12. Runners/sports shoes + spare pair in case of rain.
13. Toiletries – toothbrush/paste, comb, brush, hair ties etc.
14. Towel.
15. Play lunch, drink and Lunch for Day 1.
16. Pillow slip (camp provides pillows).
17. Sleeping bag with name on the outside cover.

*** It is likely to be very cold at the Penguin Parade. Please make sure your child has very warm clothing, even two pairs of track pants or tights/thermals etc, under track pants if possible.

Optional:

- Small teddy/bedtime friend
- Cards, small games (**nothing electronic**) to play
- Spending money (**\$20 maximum**) for souvenirs **if you wish**. We will be having a scheduled time to buy souvenirs at the camp site kiosk. Prices are cheaper than in Cowes shops. Money **MUST** be in a clearly labelled plastic zip bag to be handed to your child's class teacher prior to departure.

Your child will need to be able to manage their daily clothing requirements and be able to put on and wear fresh, clean clothes upon request but not under close teacher supervision.
