To celebrate the conclusion of our Term 1 unit of study on 'Natural Disasters', the students will be taking part in an excursion to both IMAX and the Melbourne Museum. They will view two short IMAX movies 'Forces of Nature' & 'Volcanos 3D', which are designed to educate and enlighten as much as they are to entertain the students.

*Synopsis: 'Forces of Nature' - The ground moves, mountains explode, the sky turns black and violent. The natural forces that helped create life on our green planet can also destroy it. (Rated PG)*

*Synopsis: 'Volcanos 3D' - For billions of years, volcanoes have helped forge the world we know, creating extraordinary ecosystems and wildlife habitats. Take an adventure across the globe to discover molten worlds and exploding craters, from the edge of an active volcano in Indonesia to the archaeological ghost town of Pompeii. Activities will also include a tour at the Melbourne Museum to see the exhibits 'Dynamic Earth' and the 'Forest Gallery', which will help cultivate the children's understanding of our planet and develop their knowledge of Science and Geography concepts.
