100 Days of School!

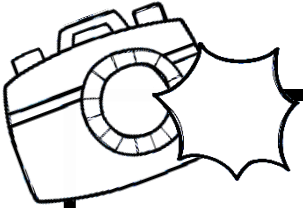
Congratulations to all of our superstars on reaching 100 days of school!! What a special milestone, we certainly celebrated in style 😊

## Important notes continued...

### Swimming Program

Our swimming program begins this Wednesday the 1<sup>st</sup> of August. Please send your child to school with their bathers already on underneath their school uniform. Students will need to bring their underwear, towel, thongs or slip on sandals and goggles to school in a SEPARATE swimming bag.

The swimming program runs for 8 consecutive days, the last day being the 10<sup>th</sup> of August. Students will need to wear bathers and bring their swimming bag (with a dry towel) to school every day. Please ensure your child has some practice at getting changed in and out of their bathers. A number of teacher and parent helpers will be available to assist but it is imperative your child has some level of independence in dressing themselves and packing their bags.

Please feel free to meet us at the pool to watch your child swim, if you would like to help in the change rooms, you must have a valid Working With Children Check copy with your classroom teacher or the office.

If your child is not attending the swimming program they will be staying back at school with a teacher completing swim safety activities.
